

# Join Us at the 22nd Annual Morro Bay Winter Bird Festival



Every Martin Luther King weekend, well over 500 birders visit Morro Bay, California, a Globally Important Bird Area, to see, photograph, and learn more about birds. Our next Festival will be held January 12-15, 2018. Birders of all levels are welcome. Beautiful Morro Bay offers pristine beaches, gorgeous state parks, an excellent natural history museum, panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean, and best of all, thousands of birds. Over 200 species were sighted during the 2017 Festival weekend.

The 2018 Festival features 138 events, including pelagic cruises, boat rides and kayaking on the Morro Bay Estuary, van and car trips throughout San Luis Obispo County, hiking trips, and many informative workshops. New for 2018 are "Bare Naked Birding" (got your attention, right?), a Feather Workshop, Field Sketching, an e-Bird workshop, and an additional ever-popular Owling Field Trip.

The Festival will again include Nature Track events, where birding is not the primary focus. Nature Track events are highlighted in turquoise on the Festival Schedule.

Youth are encouraged to participate in the Festival. Family Day will be at the Museum of Natural History on Saturday, January 13th. See the schedule of events on this brochure. Youth 17 and under are free at the museum; adults are \$3. Also, youth are encouraged to register for events on the main Bird Festival website, where the registration fee is waived for all youth 17 and under.

On Thursday, January 11th, 3:00 – 7:00 pm, we will offer early check-in at the Inn at Morro Bay located at 60 State Park Rd. You will be able to pick up your registration packets, name tags, and T-shirts. No registrations or program changes will be possible on Thursday evening.

But as birders we are also the subject of curiosity and bewilderment among much of the rest of society. And when people ask us what we like about birding we struggle to answer, because really what's not to like? George will explore the idea of being a birder in a largely non-birding world and discuss the unique space our subculture occupies within American society. He currently is the chief network officer at Rockjumper Worldwide Birding Adventures, which operates over 300 tours annually. He is also a professional wildlife guide with 20 years of experience.

David Pereksta is an Avian Biologist with the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, where he studies and analyzes the effects of offshore oil and gas and renewable energy development on birds off the Pacific coast and Hawaii.

## About the Events

### FIELD TRIP KEY:

Easy = under 1 mile, usually level ground  
Moderate = 1 to 3 miles, mostly level ground  
Strenuous = 3 miles or more, difficult terrain, thick sand, many steps, steep

### TRIP CANCELLATIONS:

Field trips go, rain or shine! Ocean trips may be cancelled at discretion of Coast Guard or ship's captain. Other trips may be cancelled at discretion of leader. Alternatives are in place if trips are cancelled.

### DEPARTURES & TRAVEL:

Field trips depart from Morro Bay Community Center, 1001 Kennedy Way, Morro Bay, or as designated in brochure, at times listed. Family Day events begin at various locations: see the schedule online. Trip lengths are approximate and include travel time back to the Community Center unless otherwise indicated in the Festival Program. *No private vehicles are allowed on van trips!* Efforts are made to rotate seating at each stop.

### GEAR & FOOD:

Be prepared for rain and chilly weather. Dress in layers. Bring binoculars, scopes, and other essentials. Poison oak is a possibility on walking field trips.

### OCEAN TRIPS:

Dress warmly and bring rain gear. No ice chests or scopes permitted. If prone to motion sickness, take appropriate measures beforehand.

### BOX LUNCHES:

If trip runs through mealtime, bring lunch or snacks. **Box lunches must be ordered in advance, and you are responsible for picking them up at the Morro Bay Community Center between 6 am and noon.**

### WATER:

Water is available to fill your own reusable bottles.

### FIELD TRIP ETIQUETTE:

**To make your excursion pleasant for all, please observe the following:**

- Turn off cell phones.
- Speak quietly and avoid loud noises.
- Avoid wearing nylon and other "rustling" fabrics.
- Stay behind leader so leader can spot and identify birds.
- Once you have seen the bird, give others a chance.
- Refrain from using scented lotions or perfumes.
- And please, no dogs.

#### General Registration:\*

Adult, age 18 or older, Full Festival, \$85  
Adult, age 18 or older, One-day (Friday, Saturday or Sunday), \$45; Monday, \$20.

(One-day registration includes events *on that day only*.)

Youth, age 17 or younger, registration is FREE. Fees for vans, boats, and kayaks still apply.

Youth, age 12 or younger must be accompanied by a registered adult.

#### Family Day Only:\*

No preregistration or registration fee is required, but some fees apply to specific events and can be paid at the event itself. See website for additional details.

\*Additional fees are charged for certain events as listed on the schedule, for adults, youth, and children.

#### Cancellation and Refund Policy:
